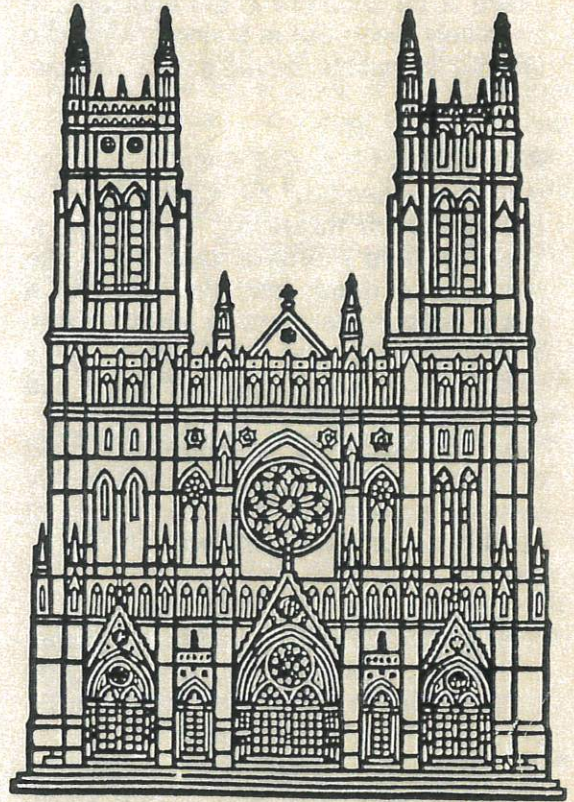

PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS

THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. JOHN THE DIVINE, the world's largest Cathedral, was begun on December 27, 1892. As the seat of the Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of New York, the Cathedral is longer than two football fields and wider than a city street, enclosing the height of a 12-story building in the soaring arches and pointed vaults of its nave. There is no concrete in the structure. It is entirely made out of Maine granite and Indiana limestone, carved and set on site.

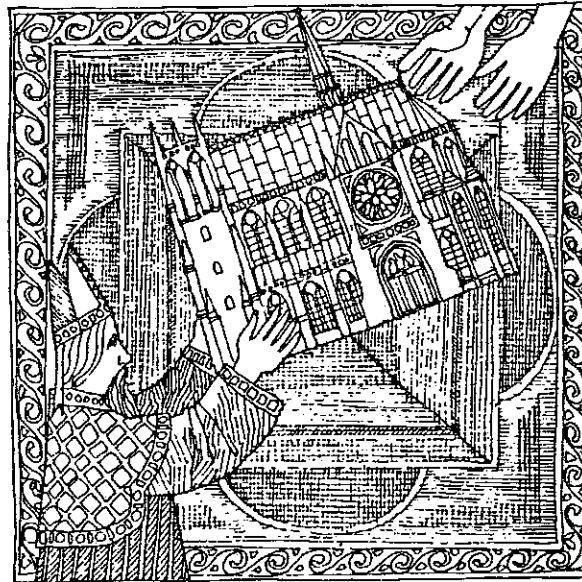
A magnificent blend of Romanesque and Gothic architecture, the Cathedral piles treasure upon treasure. The priceless Barberini and Mortlake tapestries, one made for a queen and the other for a Pope, hang in the crossing and the nave. The seven Chapels of Tongues were designed by four different architects and dedicated to an immigrant population. Paintings, sculpture, photographs, wood carvings, furniture, and extraordinary stained glass make it among the most beautiful churches in the world.

It is called the Living Cathedral. From moment to moment, the great church pulses with the life of the more than 64 programs that comprise its ministry and continues into its second century as a vibrant symbol of energy and vision for the future.

PARKING

There is parking available on Amsterdam Avenue directly in front of the Cathedral for commercial and school buses. Except when special services are taking place, coaches may park there. **IDLING IS NOT ALLOWED.** Parking for cars is available in a lot on 112th St. between Amsterdam and Broadway.

ACCESS

Wheelchair access for visitors is available on 113th St. Ramps inside allow for wheelchair users to see all areas of the Cathedral.

CATHEDRAL SHOP

The Cathedral Shop, situated by the North Aisle of the Crossing, is a delightful array of gifts, books, memorabilia and souvenirs.

RESTAURANTS

There are numerous restaurants in the neighborhood, both on Amsterdam and on Broadway. The Cathedral does not have inside eating facilities but we do invite you to eat your bag lunch around the Peace Fountain.

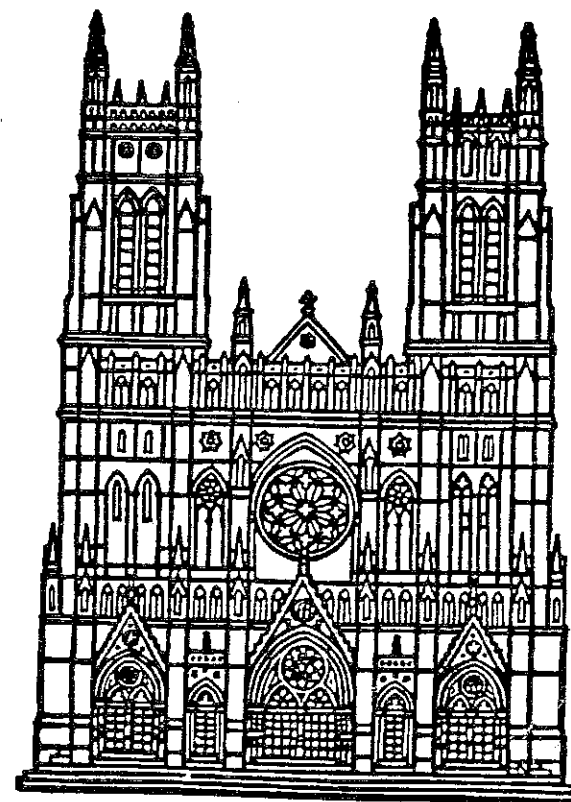
